## Curriculum Guide

The Pre-PA curriculum as completed at Union College prepares the student for application to a number of professional PA programs across the country, and is particularly suited to the goals of the Union College PA Program which awards a Master of PA Studies (MPAS) degree. Admission into the graduate PA Program is competitive and typically requires completion of a four-year degree, a separate application and personal interview. Exceptional Union College students are eligible for application to the graduate PA Program at the third year of the studies described herein.
