Senior Year

Students will be awarded a BS degree (IRR - Paramedic Emphasis) upon completion of an academically accredited paramedic program and the transfer of those hours to Union College (certificate programs will not count towards the BS degree). Union College will award 36 upper division semester hours after a student submits a copy of their National Registry EMT-P Certificate. A student graduating with the IRR - Paramedic Emphasis must be a full time student at Union College for at least three semesters prior to their overseas semester and must meet the required number of residency hours for graduation (see bulletin). Students may complete the paramedic portion of the program after the second or third year at Union. A minimum of 128 hours are required for graduation.
