Missing Student

If a member of the college community has reason to believe that a student is missing, all possible efforts are made to locate the student to determine his or her state of health and wellbeing through the collaboration of campus safety and the Vice President for Student Services. Campus safety department will enlist the aid of the neighboring police agency having jurisdiction. Concurrently college officials will endeavor to locate the student through contact with family, friends, associates, and/or employers and determine whether the student has been attending classes, labs, recitals, and scheduled college meetings/ or appearing for scheduled work shifts. Union College will file an official missing person report to the law enforcement agency with jurisdiction within 24 hours of a student missing. Campus safety will cooperate, aid, and assist the primary investigative agency in all ways prescribed by law. If located, the student's state of health and intention of returning to the campus is verified. If appropriate, a referral will be made to the Counseling Center.
